Scope of the Call

The Journal of Intelligent Information Systems Management (JIISM) welcomes the submission of original, high-quality, and previously unpublished research articles for its upcoming issue under the theme "Converging Perspectives: Interdisciplinary Approaches to Technology and Information Systems Management." It concerns papers that critically examine the multifaceted role of technology, broadly construed to include digital infrastructures, intelligent systems, computational tools, and emerging innovations shaping, transforming, and advancing the management across a wide array of sectors and institutional contexts (banking, healthcare, industry, government, education...). We particularly encourage contributions that offer theoretical advancements, methodological innovations, or empirical investigations into how the strategic deployment and governance of technology influence organizational performance, decision-making processes, stakeholder engagement, and the broader socio-technical ecosystems in which public and private entities operate.

Through this call, JIISM seeks to foster interdisciplinary dialogue and contribute to a deeper understanding of how technology, when effectively managed, can catalyze innovation, resilience, and sustainable value creation in an increasingly complex and interconnected world.

Suggested Topics

Submissions may address, but are not limited to, topics such as the integration of intelligent technologies in enterprise systems, the evolution of digital transformation strategies, the ethical and managerial implications of data-driven decision-making, cross-sectoral collaborations in technological innovation, and the development of adaptive capabilities in response to rapid technological change.

Topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

- ✓ Governance models for public-private technological collaboration

Submission Guidelines

Authors are invited to submit original, unpublished manuscripts that are not under consideration elsewhere.

The deadline for full paper submission is September 15, 2025.

Manuscripts should be between 5,000 and 8,000 words, including references, and must follow the JIISM formatting guidelines. All submissions will undergo a double-blind peer review process. Manuscripts should include an abstract (150–250 words), 4–6 keywords, and follow the APA 7th edition referencing style. Figures and tables must be high-resolution and properly labeled. Submissions must be made through the journal's e-mail.
